New Features

Run PowerShell Commands

With the CAR 1.6.1.0 release, you can run the PowerShell commands (individual, multiple separated by commas, or semicolons) to offer a quick and effective way to execute.

Example:

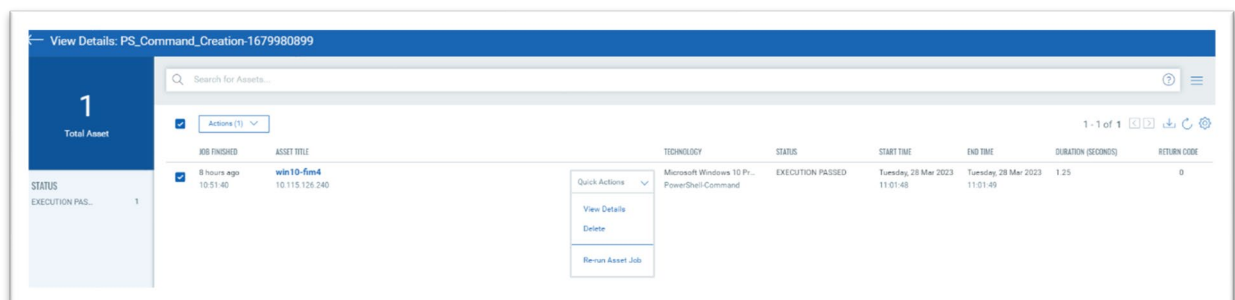
Get-Date; Get-NetIPConfiguration

Before this release, the PowerShell execution policy needed signed scripts. However, with this release, certain items can be quickly remediated by using single command through the PowerShell command line.

New Quick action to Rerun Asset Jobs

The **Rerun Asset Job** command is now available in the Quick Actions menu.

As the name suggests, Rerun Asset Job allows a job to run again. It executes the script again on the selected assets.



Audit Logs: Renamed Modify Actions

For better clarity and visibility, the action 'Modify' is now changed to 'Update' in Audit Logs.

Known Issues

- The selection of asset jobs is not retained when there is multiple asset job selection for re-run on a different page.

Workaround: Workaround: From the settings icon on the Asset jobs page, select the maximum number of rows to be displayed on a page i.e. 200, and make selections for the asset jobs to be re-run

- In case of failure from the agent for PowerShell command execution, an unexpected `os_status_code`, which is 0, is received.

Fixed Issue

Following is the known and notable issue fixed in this release:

Earlier, while executing the scripts all assets were visible including agent-based and scanned-based. However, with the CAR 1.6.1.0 release, you can view only agent-based assets while executing the script.
