

#### What's New?

#### Delete Bulk Assets from Assets Tab

You can now delete multiple assets from the Assets tab.

Navigate to **Assets** tab > **Assets**, select the required assets, and click **Delete** from the **Actions** menu.




When you delete the assets, associated mappings such as external sites and certificates also get deleted.

Note: Assets with external sites in the running state are not deleted.

#### Delete Bulk External Sites from Assets Tab

You can now delete multiple external sites from the Assets tab.


Navigate to **Assets** tab > **External Sites**, select the required sites, and click **Delete** from the **Actions** menu.



When you delete external sites, associated assets and certificates also get deleted. Note: The external sites with scans in the running state are not deleted.

### View External Sites Based on Last Scan Date

The external sites on the External Sites tab are displayed based on the last scan date. You can also sort the information as per the last scan date.




## Display User's Name in Launch Scan Page

We have improved the scan workflow for Launch Scan from the CertView module.

Earlier, when the user was launching the CertView Scan from the CertView module, the scan page from VM/VMDR displayed the POC manager user's name in the User column instead of the user.

Now with the new scan workflow, the User column displays the user's name who has launched the CertVew scan from the CertView module.



## **New Search Tokens for External Sites Tab**

Use the following search tokens to enhance your search results for the External Sites tab.

Token	Example	Description
target	target: <b>64.41.200.100</b>	Search an external site using an FQDN (Fully Qualified Domain Name) or an IP address.
lastScanStatus	lastScanStatus: Finished	Search the external sites using their last scan status. You can search the token from different values: Finished, Canceled, Waiting, Queued, Running, or Error.
lastScanDate	lastScanDate: '2022-12-05'	Search external sites using the last scan date. Use a date range or specific date.
resolvedIps	resolvedIps: <b>64.41.200.100</b>	Search external sites using IPs on which they are resolved.

## **Issues Addressed**

We fixed the issue of the wrong certificate grade. If the best-supported protocol is TLS 1.3, then the Certificate View awards GRADE A or A+, depending on other key exchanges and cipher strength.
