Add Download Report Link to Report Notification

You now have an option to add a link to the notification email to download the report once it is generated.

When you create a report or edit a report you have an option to send a notification once the report is generated. Now, you can also add a link to the notification email to download the report. Anyone with this link can download the report without having to log in to Qualys.

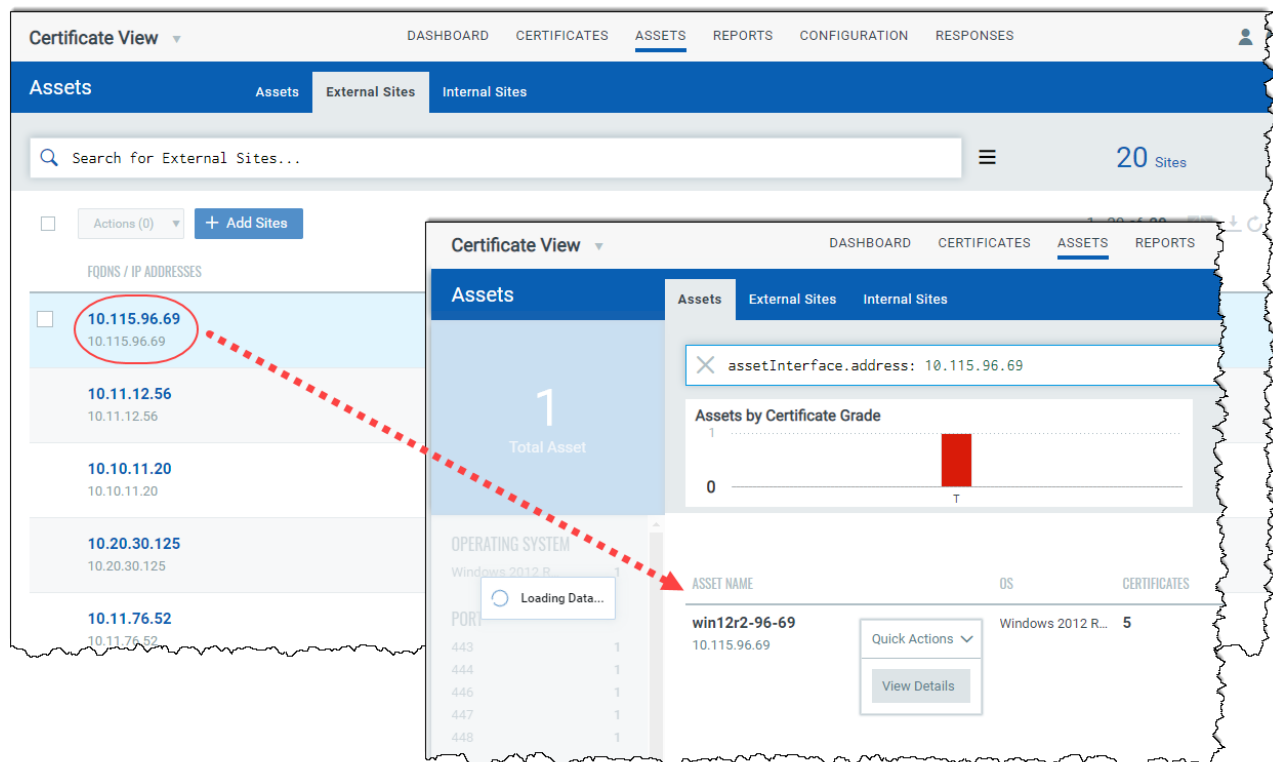

View Asset Details of the External Site

You can now easily navigate from an external site to the related asset in the Assets tab to view the details of that asset.


Navigate to Assets > External Sites and click a FQDN / IP Address from the list. You are redirected to the asset related to the selected external site. From the Quick Action menu you can now view details of the asset.



View Last Found Date of Certificate

You can now view the last found date of a certificate in the Hosts tab of your Certificate Details view.

Simply, navigate to Certificates > Monitored and choose a certificate. From the Quick Actions menu select View Details and from the Hosts tab click View Hosts button to view the Last Found date.

Issues addressed in this release

- For better clarity, we have fixed the UI text and error message that is displayed when the limit of permitted sites is exceeded while adding external sites.
- While adding external sites multiple sites with the same IP address could be added. We have fixed that issue and now an IP address can be added only once.
- There were discrepancies between the grades calculated by SSL Labs and Certificate View. We have fixed the issue and accurate grades are now displayed.
- We have updated the online help and user guide to clarify that only leaf certificates are imported as part of Import Data workflow.
