

Qualys Cloud Agent AIX 2.5.2

We're excited to tell you about new features, improvements, platform coverage changes, and fixes in this Cloud Agent release. These updates are specific to the agent binary. Platform updates for new features and fixes of management, syncing, tagging, and reporting capabilities of Cloud Agents are documented in the Cloud Platform and Cloud Suite release notes.

New Features

There are no new features in this release.

Enhancements

The following enhancements are available in this release:

- Proxy server configuration now supports multiple proxy servers
 - Up to five (5) proxy servers are supported
 - Separate each proxy server in the configuration string with a semi-colon (;)
 - Default behavior is sequential, where the agent will use the first proxy server and only try the next servers in the list if the agent is unable to connect
- Added support for multi-line regex for Policy Compliance File Content Check User Defined Control
- Updates and changes to libraries utilized by the Cloud Agent as follows:
 - OpenSSL bundled library upgraded
 - Curl bundled library upgraded
 - SQLite bundled library upgraded
 - POCO bundled library upgraded

Behavior Changes

There are no behavior changes in this release.

Platform Coverage Support (Operating Systems)

Added support for AIX 7.1 TL5 SP4.

Fixed Defects

The following known reported and notable issues have been fixed in this release:

ID	Description
CRM-58829	Fixed false negative for QID 372013
CRM-55424	Agent-side fix for QID FNs (370833, 370953, 371180). Requires server-side fix for full end-to-end support (not yet released as of the date of this document, tracked as CAS-3445).
CRM-45943	Fixed in a manifest upgrade released in January 2019

Known Limitations and Workarounds

The following notable known limitations are open in this release:
