

Qualys Cloud Agent Linux 4.9 (x64)

We're excited to tell you about new features, improvements, platform coverage changes, and fixes in this Cloud Agent release. These updates are specific to the agent binary. Platform updates for new features and fixes of management, syncing, tagging, and reporting capabilities of Cloud Agents are documented in the Cloud Platform and Cloud Suite release notes.

New Features

- Context Extended Detection and Response (XDR) is supported for the Cloud Agent on the following platforms:
 - o Red Hat Enterprise Linux 6.x, 7.x, and 8.x
 - o CentOS 6.x, 7.x, and 8.x
- For Patch Management (PM) 1.7.0.0 module:
 - Support for the Cloud Agent on the following platforms:
 - Ubuntu 18.04 LTS, 20.04 LTS, and 21.10
 - Debian 9.x, 10.x, and 11.x
 - o Support for telemetry data and interim results

Enhancements

There are no enhancements in this release.

Behavior Changes

- Agent Scan Merge
 - Added support to run agentid service as a non-root user regardless of the UseSudo value. This is applicable only when User=option is configured.
 - If you are using custom port numbers lower than 1024 for scan-merge service, update to a higher port number. If you are using the default ports, no change is required.

Fixed Defects

The following reported and notable issues have been fixed in this release.

Known Limitations and Workarounds

Proxy user name and password is getting displayed in the Cloud agent log files.
