We're excited to tell you about new features, platform coverage changes, improvements, and bug fixes in the Cloud Agent Windows 1.6.3 release. These updates are specific to the agent binary. Platform updates for new features and fixes of management, syncing, tagging, and reporting capabilities of Cloud Agents are documented in the Cloud Suite release notes.



New Features

No new features in this release.

Enhancements

Cloud Agent now compresses snapshot and delta uploads for Inventory, Vulnerability Management, and Policy Compliance modules before uploading to Qualys Platform.

- This is an always-on feature and is not user-configurable.
- Cloud Agent deployments can expect to see up to 4x reduction in data size uploaded from agent to the Qualys Platform reducing the bandwidth usage of enterprise networks.
- For example, a 1 MB delta upload can be reduced to 250 KB at full compression. Actual data size may vary depending on network connectivity, delays, dropped packets, and other environmental variables.
- Compression utilization is managed by the "CPU Limit" value in the Configuration Profile.

Behavior Changes

Log file compression now follows the "CPU Limit" value in the Configuration Profile
