WAS API: Support for URLs with Non-standard TLDs

With this release, we support addition of URLs with non-standard TLDs in domain while creating or updating a web application. Earlier, addition of URLs with non-standard TLDs returned an error.

Sample - Create a Web Application

API request:

```
curl -u fo_username:password -X POST -H "Content-Type: text/xml" -H "X-  
Requested-With: curl" --data-binary @post_data.xml  
"https://qualysapi.qualys.com/qps/rest/3.0/create/was/webapp/"
```

Note: "post_data.xml" contains the request POST data.
