URL to the Qualys API Server

Qualys maintains multiple Qualys platforms. The Qualys API server URL that you should use for API requests depends on the platform where your account is located.

Delete Connector API: Change in parameter name

We have changed the parameter name for delete connector API. The new parameter name `connectorIds` is easy to use. Simply, specify the unique ID of the connector in the array [string] format. You can delete multiple connectors by specifying multiple IDs in an array.

Operation affected	DELETE

Sample

Let us delete two connector by specifying their connector IDs.

API request:

```
curl -X DELETE --header 'Content-Type: application/json' --header 'Accept: */*' --header 'Authorization: Basic VVNFUk5BTUU6UEFTUldPUkQ='  
-d '[ \"fd74dae1-330f-11e8-a629-af152234f88c\", \"fd74dae1-330f-11e8-a629-af152234f88f\" ]'  
'https://<QualysURL>/cloudview-api/rest/1.5/aws/connectors'
```

Response:

204
