

Qualys Container Scanning Connector for Bamboo

Here's what's new in the Qualys Container Scanning Connector for Bamboo!

- We will now use the "lastScanned" filter in the API call to ensure that the plugin fetches the latest scan result for the specified image ID.
- The plugin will now check before tagging the image if the sensor container is running on the host and if it is installed in the CI/CD mode.
- With this release, the plugin will use API v1.3.
- We will now support "AE Platform" (Dubai). If your account resides on this platform, then enter this URL platform in the "API Server URL" field in the "API Login" section on the plugin configuration page. See [here](#) the list of supported platforms. We have removed support for US POD 4 platform.
- When multiple images are specified in the image ID input and during the scan, if the build timeout is reached for any of them, then the plugin will generate the scan result and render the report for the images for which it receives the scan data.
- From this release, when you pass image ID or image name in the input parameter, the plugin will internally use the SHA value of the image to call the CS API.
- We removed the Test Connection button from the plugin configuration form. Plugin will now test the connection when you click Save to save the configuration. An error is shown if the call to the Container Security API by the plugin fails.
