

ImageID column added to Containers List CSV report

A new column to display the image ID for each container has been added to the Containers List CSV report. Download this report by going to Assets > Containers and choosing the Download option above the data list (on the right side). When you filter the list using a search query your downloaded report will only include the containers that match your query.

Here's a sample report showing the new IMAGE ID column.



New search tokens for container runtime


These new search tokens are available when searching sensors:

containerRuntime – This token is available to find a container based on the Runtime type. Possible values are Docker and ContainerD.


containerRuntimeVersion – This token is available to find the Runtime version you're interested in. This is either the Docker version or the ContainerD version.

Change to Integrations page

The next time you go to Configurations > Integrations you'll notice that the Download button for the Jenkins and Bamboo plugins has been replaced with Show Instructions. This way we can provide you with all the information you need, all in one place. Click this button and you'll get detailed step-by-step installation instructions along with details on how to get the plugin.
