
Onboarded Azure Active Directory Audit Collector New Improvement for Assets Details Enhancements to Assets Tab Removal of DLQ Tab

Context XDR 1.0.7 brings you more improvements and updates!

### **Onboarded Azure Directory Audit Collector**

We now support Azure Directory Audit cloud collector that allows you to ingest the audit logs/events into Context XDR to enrich data from other log sources.


Navigate to **Configuration** > **Data Collection** > **Catalog**. Navigate to the **Microsoft Azure Directory Audit** tile and click Configure Cloud Azure Directory Audit. Enter the required details to configure the Azure Directory Audit collector and click **Save**. Once the collector binds successfully, the collector status appears as Configured under the **Sources** tab.




#### **New Improvement for Assets Details**

With this release, we have newly added XDR section on the **Assets Details** page. Now, you can view the complete summary details of an asset such as signals, events, and Mitre tactics etc.

Navigate to **Threat Management** > **Threat Hunting** and click the Asset to view the **Asset Details** page.



You can view the newly added XDR tab under the Security drop-down menu.



#### **Enhancements to Assets Tab**

We have newly added the **Asset Name**, **Events**, **Agent Version**, and **Last Agent Status** columns on the Assets Tab.

**Asset Name** – Displays the name and details of an Asset.


**Events** – Displays if the events are streaming or not.

**Agent Version** – Displays the agent version associated with the asset.

**Last Agent status** – Displays the last agent status of an asset.

Note that the Last Agent Status is currently displayed only for Windows OS and for Linux OS - it is displayed as Not available.

Navigate to **Configuration** > **Cloud Agent Profiles** > **Assets** to view the newly added details.



#### Removal of DLQ Tab

With this release, we have removed the **DLQ** tab from the **Threat management**. You can directly view the unparsed events under the **Events** tab.

Navigate to **Threat Management** > **Events** tab, and click **Unparsed** to view to the unparsed events.
