
Display Correlation Rule ID Tokens Updated Run Again Option Creates a new Report

Display Correlation Rule ID

We now display the correlation rule ID on the Correlation Rules tab under Incidents. This rule id can be used to:

- Create incident-based alerts.
- Update, delete, activate, and deactivate correlation rules using API.

You can also view the correlation rule ID on the View and Edit page under Quick Actions menu.



Tokens Updated

To give you a granular-level understanding of the agent and manifest status, we have added some new options to the following tokens:

- agentService.status
 - o CONFIG_PROFILE_APPLIED: Agent has applied the updated configuration, and the new configuration is in effect.
 - o CONFIG_PROFILE_DOWNLOAD_SUCCESS: Agent has successfully downloaded the updated agent configuration profile from the Platform.
 - o CONFIG_PROFILE_DOWNLOAD_FAILED: There was an error while downloading the updated agent configuration profile from the Platform.
 - o FIM ENABLED: FIM has been enabled in the agent configuration profile.
 - o FIM_DISABLED: FIM has been disabled in the agent configuration profile.
- manifest.status
 - o FIM_MANIFEST_ASSIGNMENT_FAILED: There was an error while downloading the new manifest from the Platform. The agent will continue to use the older manifest applied.



Run Again Option Creates a new Report

After you click the Run Again option under the Quick Actions menu on the Reports tab, it will now generate a new report with the same name but updated data, date, and time. This feature will enable you to compare the previous and current data.

Note: You cannot rerun reports that have special characters in their name.
