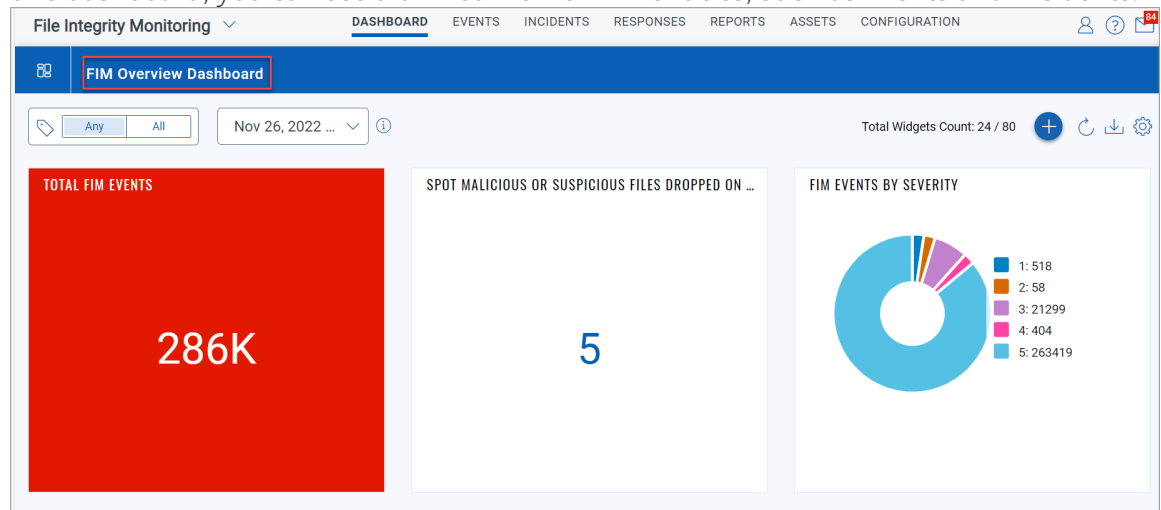

## New Dashboard: FIM Overview Dashboard

With this release, we introduced a new dashboard, the FIM Overview Dashboard. From this dashboard, you can see a unified view of FIM entities, such as Events and Incidents.



## Visibility to Events Success Status

With this release, we introduced the Success Status on the **Event Details** page. The Success Status is shown as **yes** when the event is successfully executed and **no** when the event execution is unsuccessful.

### Prerequisites:

- For Windows, the Cloud Agent version 5.5 and later
- For Linux, the cloud agent version 6.2 and later

## New API Features

We have added three new APIs:

- Bulk Delete Profiles API:** To delete monitoring profiles based on the profile IDs.

- **Import Profile API with CSV:** To create FIM monitoring profiles from CSV files that contain monitoring profile data with asset and tag information.
- **Export Profile API With CSV:** To export FIM monitoring profiles with asset and tag information to a CSV file.

## New Tokens

With this release, we added new tokens to search profiles.

Token	Description	Example
profile.name	Filters profiles based on the name.	profile.name:"Windows Monitoring Profile"
createdBy	Filters profiles created by the specific users.	createdBy: "Tom"
RegistryRulesImported	Filters profiles based on whether the registry rules are imported or not.	registryRulesImported:True
platform	Filters profiles for Windows or Linux OS.	platform: Windows
SyncWithLibrary	Filters profiles based on whether they synced with a library.	syncWithLibrary: true

You can use **successStatus** token to view the success status.

Token	Description	Example
successStatus	Filters events based on their success status.	successStatus:yes

## Issues Fixed

- Earlier, the issue was observed that users were not able to click on the **Edit** button on the dashboard. With this release, this issue is fixed.
- Earlier, one of the FIM Dashboards would disappear after refreshing the page. With this release, this issue is fixed, and you can view all FIM Dashboards after refreshing the page.
