Here's what's new in Patch Management 1.4.1.2!

[Add to Existing Job option](#) will allow only patch modifications

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When you modify a patch job using the “Add to Existing Job” option, you can add patches, but cannot add target assets or asset tags. To apply patches to an asset that is not added to the job, you can either edit an existing job from the Jobs tab or create a new patch job for that asset.
