
Deploy Patches for Assets from the Assets tab

You can now create new deployment jobs from the Assets tab. From the asset tab, you have the options to choose assets and then either create a new deployment job for these assets or add these assets in an existing job.

To add assets to a new job, select the assets on which you want to apply the patch and then from the Quick Actions Menu of a single asset or from the Actions menu (bulk actions) click "Add to New Job". The Create: Deployment Job wizard/workflow is same as you see when you create a job from the Jobs tab.


You also have the option to add assets later to existing jobs. To add assets to an existing job, select assets and click Add to Existing Job. You cannot add assets later to OnDemand or runonce (non recurring) jobs once they are enabled.

When adding assets to an existing job, if some of the assets you are adding is already added to one or more selected jobs then we will add the assets to the jobs that do not have the asset added and skip adding assets to the jobs that already have the selected assets.




Display Asset Count in Tagged Assets on the Job List page

On the Jobs tab, we have split Assets Count column in two columns to help you identify assets in a job that are added directly to a job and that are added as part of a tag. Under Assets Count, the Tagged Assets column will show the total number of assets in the asset tags that are added to a job and the Assets column will show the total number of assets that are added directly to a job.




When you can click a value in the Tagged Asset or Assets column, we redirect you to the Job Details page in view mode and Asset tab shows the asset details. Similarly, when you click a value in Patches column, we redirect you to the Job Details page in view mode and Asset tab shows the asset details.




Display "Not Licensed" Status for Assets Not Licensed

We now show you the assets that are not licensed on the Job Progress screen for a job that is either running or completed. We skip patch installation for these assets. To view not licensed assets, select a job and from the Quick Actions menu, click View Progress.



Severity column on patch Listing Page is renamed to Vendor Severity

We have renamed Severity column to Vendor Severity column on the pages/screens where we are listing patches.




On the List: Patch Selector screen:



Job Details Screen to Show New Information

In the Job details screen, we now show three new fields: 1)Patch Window - to show whether the patch window for the job is open or closed, 2)GUID - to show the ID of the job, and 3) Time Zone - to show the time zone of job.



Issues Addressed

- We fixed an issue where the user was shown the "No Records Found" message when on the Assets tab, the user that had more than 200 assets chose the filter to show more than 100 assets on the page. Now you can choose the filter to show more than 100 assets on the page.
- We have fixed an issue where on the Patches tab, we were showing record count of previous search query for the current search query that did not return any records.
