

MacOS support in Patch Management

With the Patch Management 2.0.0.0 release, MacOS support is also now available in Patch Management.



Prerequisite

- Mac agent binary 4.25 or later for x64, x86_64, and binary 4.26 or later for arm64 architecture. Contact your Technical Account Manager (TAM) to get these binaries.


You can deploy patches that are available in the following operating system repositories:

- macOS 10.15 Catalina
- macOS 11 Big Sur
- macOS 12 Monterey
- macOS 13 Ventura (3rd party and OS security update)

Dashboard Supports MacOS Widgets

With this release, Patch Management now supports MacOS widgets on the Dashboard. You can choose from the 5 out-of-the-box or customize the widgets. You need to add the MacOS widgets to your existing dashboard.



Issues Addressed

- We have fixed an issue where it was not possible sometimes to add the 'cloud agent' tag under the **Configuration** > **Licenses** tab.
- We have fixed the issue with the width of the Title column of the patches. As the width of that column was smaller, the full patch name was not visible when the patch was selected. The full name of the patch was visible only by hovering over it.
- We fixed an issue about some jobs getting stuck in the **Preparing** status.
- We have fixed the issue where the search query for the systemManufacturer and systemModel tokens was not working.
- We have fixed the issue where though many agents were not activated or available in PM, the PM licenses were shown as exceeding the license limit.
- We have fixed the issue where the search query for the interface address token was not working as expected.
