



# Risk Reduction Recommendation - Patch Prioritization with Group By Product

The **Group By** option is added on the **Prioritized Products** > **Risk Reduction Recommendation** tab. Using the **Group By** option, you can filter the latest recommended patches based on the product name and get visibility to corresponding critical and high QIDs product-wise.



When you click the count from the **CRITICAL QIDs** or **HIGH QIDs** column, you can see the **MAX QDS SCORE** column in the pop-up. The Max QDS Score is the score found for assets where the listed QIDs are missing.




By using the **Patch Now** option, you can mitigate the vulnerabilities. When you click the **Patch Now** option, a QQL-based new job is created.

#### Manual Asset Addition to Jobs - Limit Increased from 50 to 100

Before the Patch Management 2.6.0.0 release, you could manually add up to a maximum of 50 assets in a deployment job. With this release, this limit is increased. As a result, you can manually add up to 100 assets in a deployment job. This applies to Windows, Linux, and Mac jobs.


**Note:** This is applicable to the "Include Assets to this job" option.



## **Report Generation - Support for Mac Patches**

Like Windows and Linux, you can now generate the Mac Patches Report. To generate the Mac

Patches report, navigate to the **Patches** > **Mac** tab and click the **Download** icon. The report is generated in the CSV format. Go to the "Report Download Request Status" page, and when the report status is "Ready", you can download the report.



#### **Enable Vendor-Acquired Patch for On-demand Jobs**

The Vendor-Acquired patch enablement is now supported for the on-demand jobs as well.

**Note:** The required cloud agent version for vendor-acquired patch enablement for on-demand jobs is 5.2 and above. For more information, see Enable Vendor Acquired Windows Patch.

## **Issues Addressed**

- Fixed various issues related to email notifications:
  - o Though the patch jobs were executed as scheduled, the email notifications customers received for job start and completion were inconsistent with the job schedule.
  - o Sometimes, for the scheduled jobs, irregular email notifications were sent in some cases; for example, multiple email notifications were sent for the same job.
  - o Sometimes, the customer did not receive the email notification for the job start or job completion.
- Fixed the issue with adding or removing tags from the Assessment Profile.
- Some customers encountered the "FileHasValidationFailed" issue. This issue was due to some old, unsupported patches. We have now purged such patches to fix this issue.
