

View Expiration Date for False Positives Receive Notifications for Expiry of False Positive Requests

View Expiration Date for False Positives

We now show future expiration dates for false positives requests that are approved on the False Positive Request History page. After a false positive is expired, the status of the false positive is changed to expired if you do not submit a new false positive request for the vulnerability.



Receive Notifications for Expiry of False Positive Requests

You can now configure how many days before the expiry of false positive requests you want to receive daily email notifications. To set expiry notification for false positives, go to Account > Settings and click Edit to edit the merchant information. Specify a value from 1 to 60 in the "False Positive expiry notification (in days)" field. The default value for receiving daily notifications is seven days. In the email, we will let you know the total number of false positive requests expiring and days remaining for expiry.

To edit your account settings, go to Account > Settings. Click Edit in the Merchant Information section.
